Roster Choices

Coles are giving you choices to change what your Meat Agreement is offering you. All this before it is even stamped by the FWC



You do not have to agree to any of the offers. You do not have to agree to changes you do not want.

If you like having Two days off together, you can keep having consecutive days off as it currently stands in the

If the offer to vary the way you have your days off in either cycle sounds right for you then by all means tick the box and vary your roster.

Part Time Team Members, if you agree to the **Coles** offer this means any **extra hours you accept will be paid at normal hours**. You **do not** have to accept you **can still have extra hours** offered to you but with the Meat Agreement these hours are **paid at overtime rates, this is your right**. You currently can choose anytime to change this on an ad-hoc basis.

20 days per 4 week cycle, if you **currently are working this arrangement** and are **happy** with the way it is for you then obviously **ticking this box** will have no impact on you, and you should tick this box. If you are **happy** with your **19 day 4 week cycle**, and **currently are paid an average over that cycle** then how you are paid is all that is changing in the New Meat Agreement.

Choices 1 & 2 Give you the option to withdraw your consent by providing 4 weeks notice.

Choice 3 gives the option to change via your line manager or updating your Roster Choice on my Coles

Choice 4,5,6&7 do not seem to offer any choice to withdraw

If you have already submitted your choices and wish to rescind them we suggest you talk to your manager or call your union
